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The cottage is a traditional croft house, which has been the MacKenzie family home for four generations. It was recently refurbished, offers comfortable accommodation and is well equipped to make your stay relaxed. The cottage has central heating throughout and an open coal fire in the sitting room. There is an enclosed garden and a small conservatory to the front with views over Loch Diabaig and to the Isle of Skye in the distance.

There are three bedrooms, two with double beds and one with twin beds, a cot is available. Bed linen and towels are provided. The bathroom has a bath and overhead shower. Electricity is charged extra, as used during your stay.

There is ample car parking space for several vehicles.

Up to 2 pets are welcome (£12 per pet per week extra)

Visitors can enter from 4pm on day of arrival and must vacate by 10am on day of departure.

Bookings are taken Saturday to Saturday



Diabaig is a small fishing and crofting village. It is set just above sea level looking towards the Applecross Peninsula. As a base for walking it offers a wide range of opportunities, with walks at all levels. The village was the location for a significant part of the film "Loch Ness" starring Joely Richardson and Ted Danson

Diabaig is eight miles west of Torridon, where there is a grocery shop, a hotel, restaurant and bar. There

are also recommended restaurants slightly further afield.

Fresh free-range eggs are available from the poultry project in Inveralligin, which is well worth a visit.

Fishing is available locally on river, loch and sea by appropriate arrangement.





Diabaig is a central location for exploring the magnificent mountain and seascapes of Wester Ross.

It is approximately one hours drive from Inverness, the most direct route from the South; the approach from Fort William on the West, is more scenic but slower. The Isle of Skye is about an hour and a half distant. Applecross, Glenelg with its well-preserved Brochs, Inverewe Gardens, Gairloch and Ullapool are places of interest to visit and equally accessible. There are golf courses in Lochcarron and in Gairloch, which also has beautiful sands. Swimming pools can be visited in Poolewe and Kyle of Lochalsh

### Directions to Diabaig:

**From Inverness**, take the A9 north. After 6 miles take the A835 towards Ullapool. Turn left at Garve on to the A832 towards Achnasheen. At Achnasheen turn right at roundabout towards Kinlochewe. At Kinlochewe turn left on the A896 to Torridon then turn right on the road sign-posted to Inveralligin and Diabaig.

Continue for 8 miles until you reach the village of Diabaig. At the post box halfway down the hill turn right and continue to the road end where the cottage is before you.



**From Fort William**, take the A82 to Invergarry, turn left onto the A87 towards Kyle of Lochalsh. About four miles before Kyle of Lochalsh turn right on to the A890 towards Lochcarron (sign-posted "The North"). At Strathcarron, beyond the railway crossing turn left to Lochcarron (A896) and continue for 22 miles to Torridon. Turn left for Inveralligin and Diabaig and continue as above
